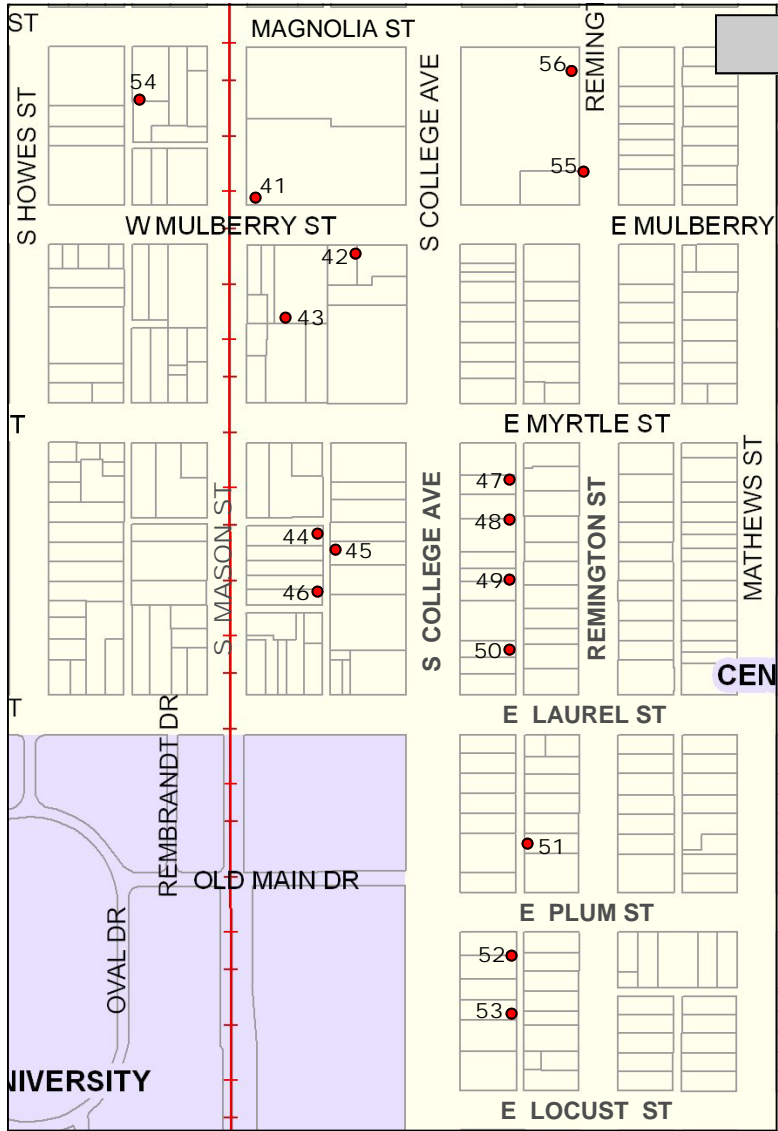
**TRANSFORMER
