Guidelines:

- 1. Please complete and return this form.
- 2. Work with your students/group to create concept drawings for the can(s).
- 3. Submit concept images using the attached form or via e-mail (jpegs). All images must be labeled with the school/organization name and address, instructor/leader, phone number, and student grade/age ranges. If you choose to include the name of your school/organization within the design, please do not use text over 3" in height, and please do not make it the focal point of the design. We are looking for murals that are visually active/busy, so as not to leave large open spaces. Make the design picture-based, not word-based. Designs that include logos, copyrighted or trademarked images, advertisements, or political, commercial, religious, or sexual symbols, themes or messages will not be accepted. Designs should be appropriate for a diverse, broad-based audience of all ages.
- 4. Approval of design concepts is in the City's sole discretion. If concepts are approved, supplies and trash can(s) will be delivered. You will have one month to complete the project. Completed projects that aren't consistent with the approved design may be rejected.
- 5. Please take images of cans being painted or images of the trash cans once they are completed. These images will be used for publicity purposes.
- 6. A time will be scheduled for City Park staff to pick up the cans and left over materials.
