




Implementation Plan Process

This diagram shows the process and inputs that will be used to prioritize recommended projects and programs and develop a funding and phasing plan. The Bike Plan Goals/Themes form the foundation for the implementation plan and performance measures, which will be used to track the effectiveness of implemented projects and programs.











Implementation Strategies

 Create a citywide low-stress bike network > focus on non-arterial bike routes, neighborhood greenways and critical crossing improvements 	
 Improve existing bikeways reduce the stress-level of existing bike facilities 	
 Expand coverage of bike network >adding new bike facilities where none exist today 	
 Build as much of the recommended bike network as quickly as possible focus on low-cost and partnering opportunities 	
 Focus on high-visibility, high-use projects such as protected bikeways on major commercial corridors 	
 Raise the visibility of bicycling through demonstration projects and bike events such as Open Streets 	
 Promote biking as a viable transportation option by expanding education and encouragement activities 	
Encourage safer conditions for biking >by enforcing traffic laws	
 Measure FC Bikes program effectiveness by evaluating project/program success and overall progress
