In October 2000, the Fort Collins' City Council approved the overall Master Plan for the Mason Street Transportation Corridor (MSTC), including the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) alternative and the bicycle/pedestrian improvements.

The MSTC is a five and ½ mile north-south byway within the City of Fort Collins which extends from Cherry Street on the north to approximately ½ mile south of Harmony Road. The MSTC for most of its length is situated within the Burlington Northern Santa Fe ROW and is centered along the railway tracks, located a few hundred feet west of College Avenue (US287).
