BOARD RESOLUTION TO CITY COUNCIL

DATE: November 9, 2006

SUBJECT: Transportation cuts (dial-a-ride) and transportation policy

Dear Mayor and members of City Council,

At our October meeting, the Fort Collins Air Quality Advisory Board passed a unanimous recommendation to Council as follows:

The AQAB recommends transportation planning based on an all inclusive mobility management strategy to yield a comprehensive approach for fee assessment and reduction in taxpayer burdens.*

Recognizing that the proposed Transportation Management Fee does not fully address the needs of the entire community, future plans and related fees must:

- *Assess the impact on meeting policy goals to improve air quality*
- *Recognize the transportation needs of the entire community*
- *Address the availability and impacts of fossil fuels*
- *Include actions for enhanced public transit*

Over the next year, as the AQAB continues to assess mobility management strategies and implications on air quality, we will provide specific action items for council consideration.
