1. Call Meeting to Order.
2. Presentation and Discussion of the Water Supply Policy. (1 hour)

The purpose of this study session is to share with the Council the results of the staff's analysis of the City's water supply system and some recommended changes to the Water Supply Policy.

3. Discussion Regarding Secondhand Tobacco Smoke Reduction. (1 hour)

Staff seeks guidance from the City Council on possible revisions to the City's tobacco smoking ordinance. Based on earlier discussions, including presentations to the Council's Health and Safety Committee, Staff poses several questions about possible changes to the existing ordinance.

1. In what locations and establishments would new requirements or prohibitions related to smoking apply; such as tobacco retailers, restaurants seating 30 or under, liquor establishments, hotel/motel rooms, nursing home/long-term care, or outdoor venues?
 2. For those locations to which new provisions would apply, should there be designated areas in which smoking is allowed?
 3. Should new requirements related to employers' policies or practices related to smoking in the workplace be established?
4. Other Business.
 5. Adjournment.
