- Applications are reviewed by the Cultural Resources Board of the City of Fort Collins and recommendations to fund events are submitted to the Fort Collins City Council for final approval.






#### **Fort Fund**

- To encourage and enhance artistic expression and art appreciation while adding value to the Fort Collins community through acquiring, exhibiting and maintaining public art.
- 1% Program: City government capital projects with a budget over \$250,000 designate 1% of the project budget for art.




