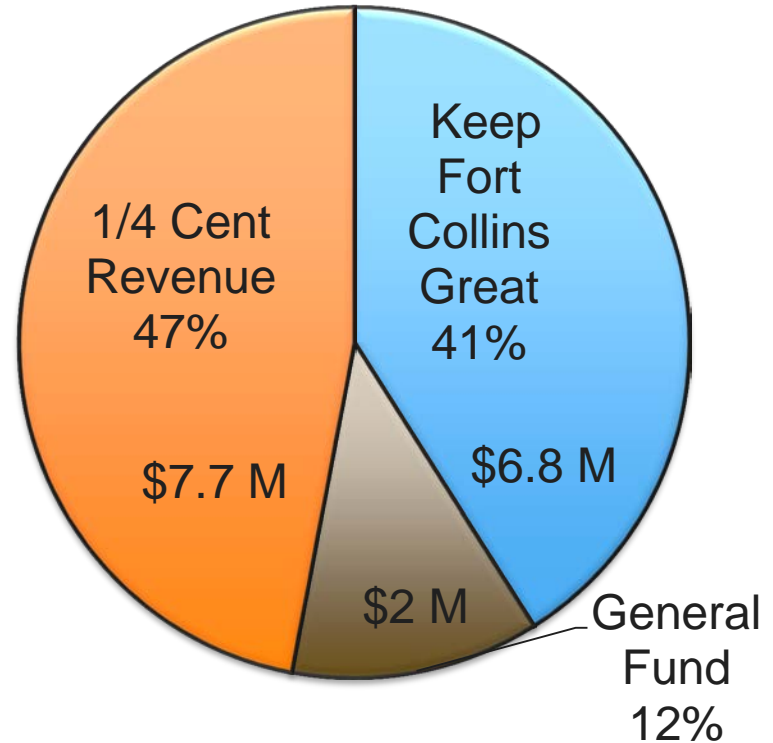


- **Streets Maintenance Program** \$16,486,000

- **Graffiti Abatement** \$102,700

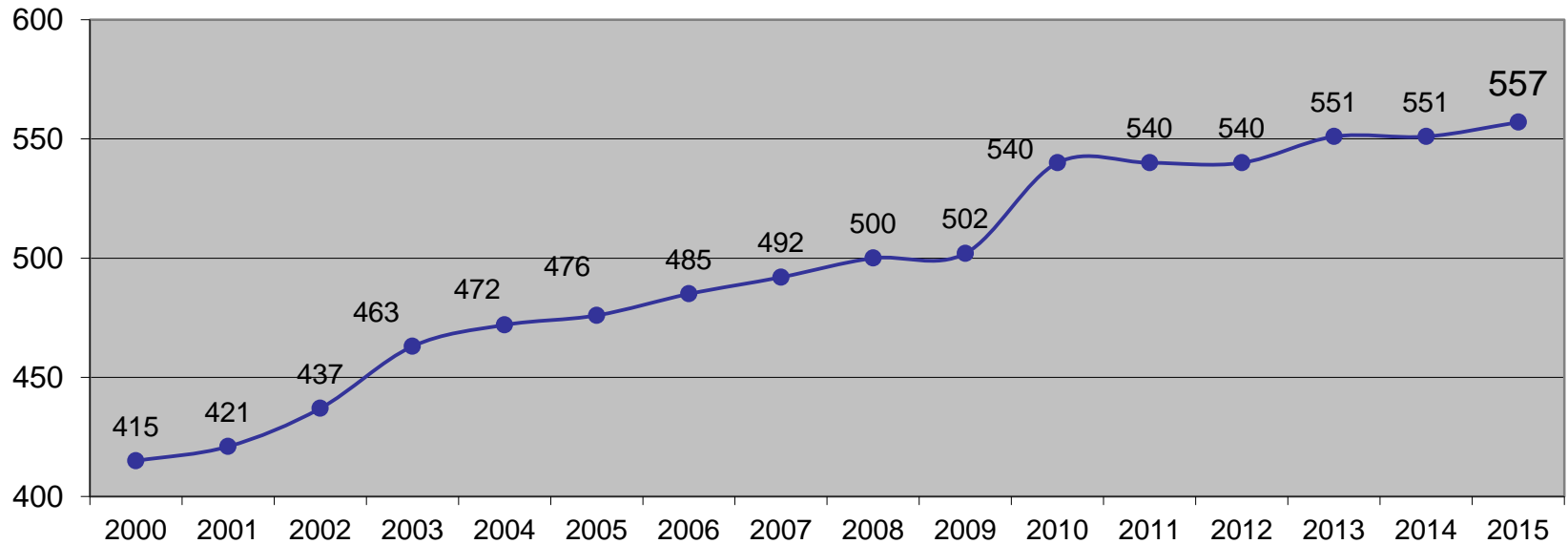


# Street Maintenance Funding

- Program has had dedicated funding since 1989.
- ¼ Cent Street Maintenance Tax was extended on April 7th, 2015. Sunsets Dec. 31, 2025
- KFCG Tax: 2011-2020 (33% goes to SMP). Sunsets Dec. 31, 2020



## Growth in Fort Collins Road Miles 2000-2015



- Provides maintenance on all City streets:
  - Arterials, Collectors, and Residential Streets
- Management of overall street network.
- Maintain safe and accessible street pavement, sidewalks, curb and gutter.

- Keep good roads good - good roads cost less to maintain
- Seals pavement surface
- Refreshes driving surfaces
- Reconditions asphalt
- Extends life of pavement
- Protects \$440 million investment

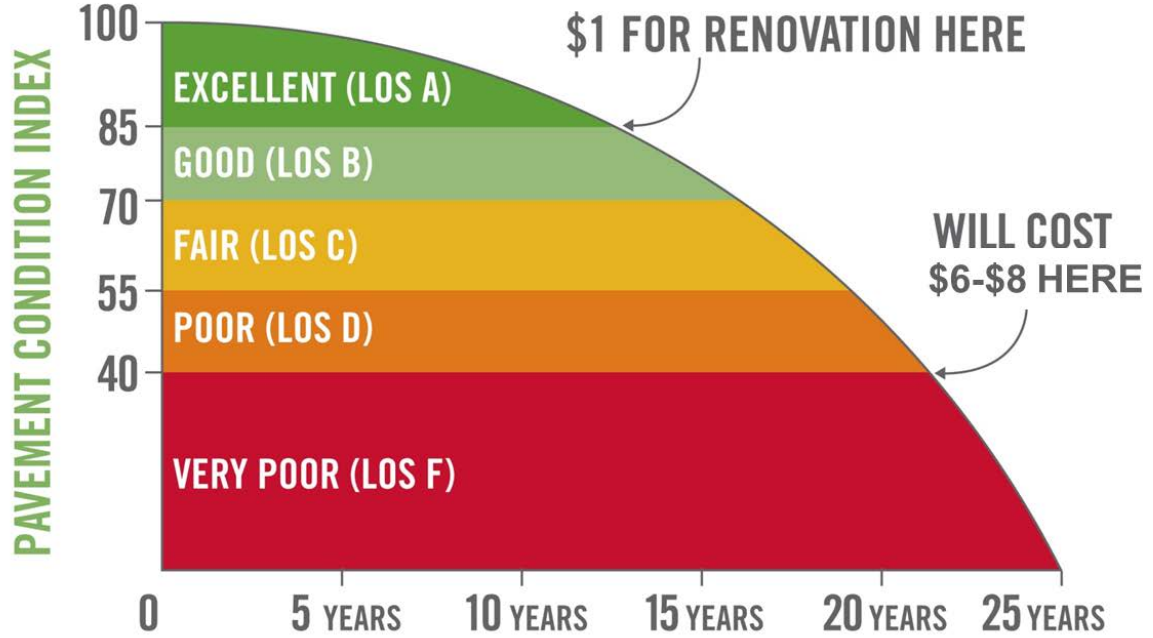

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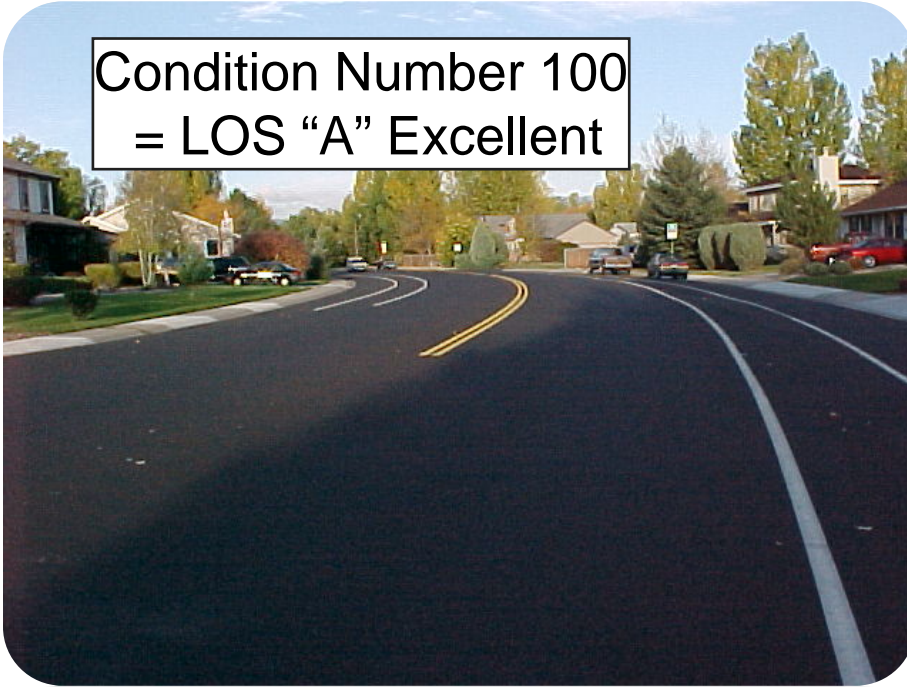




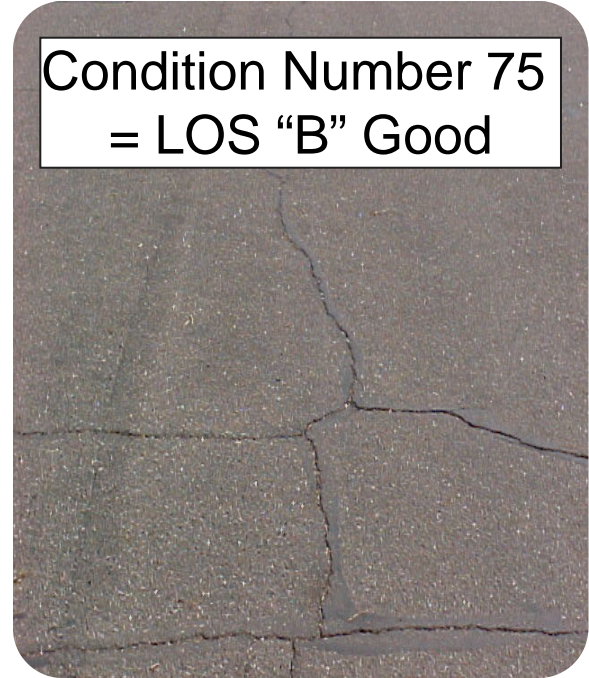

= LOS "A" Excellent



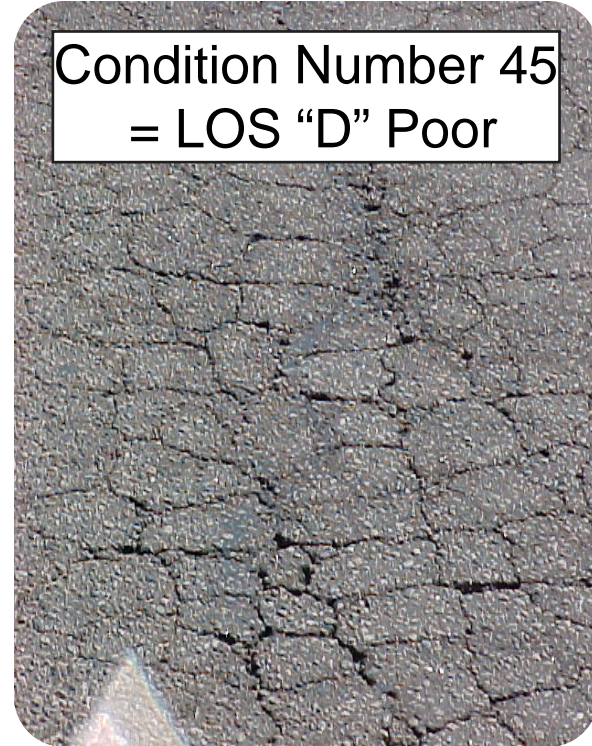
Condition Number 75

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**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**What are you expecting? How do you decide what needs to be repaired?**  
We will be replacing damaged concrete such as potholes and curbs that are cracked or pink pavers. The marked repairs will be made by the contractor and are a separate issue or accountability. Safety hazards, severe drainage, and issues that are beyond the scope of the project are not included in this project. Council approval is not required for this project.

**What if my sidewalk is not marked for repair, can I have it fixed?**  
The additional cost to have a sidewalk or driveway repaired is not included in the project's budget. The contractor will need to contact the City of Fort Collins (303-441-3885) to schedule any additional work.

**How long before I can use my sidewalk or driveway?**  
Check the new concrete to ensure your sidewalk or driveway will be repaired within 2-3 days (including weekends) to allow sufficient cure time. We will have a sign on your driveway during the time. Concrete and forms will be removed when you are able to use your sidewalk.

**What if my landscaping or sprinklers are damaged during construction?**  
If you have a sprinkler, the contractor will need to remove 2 inches of topsoil and a few inches of the back of the sidewalk in order to complete the repair. After the repair, topsoil will be backfilled, reseeded, and sprayed with mulch.

The City of Fort Collins appreciates your patience as we complete these improvements to the Project Corridor, and will do our best to limit our impacts to the residents and businesses within the work areas.

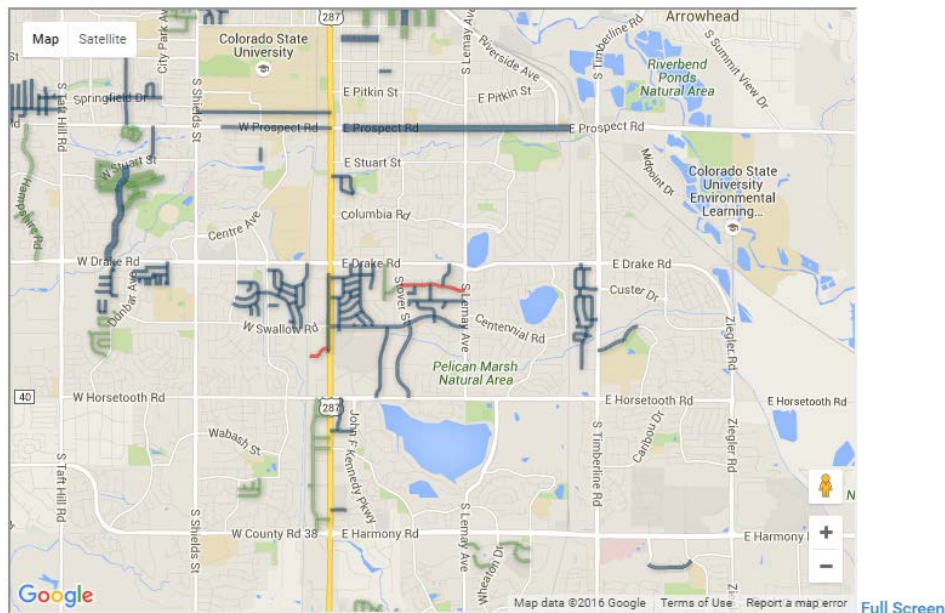

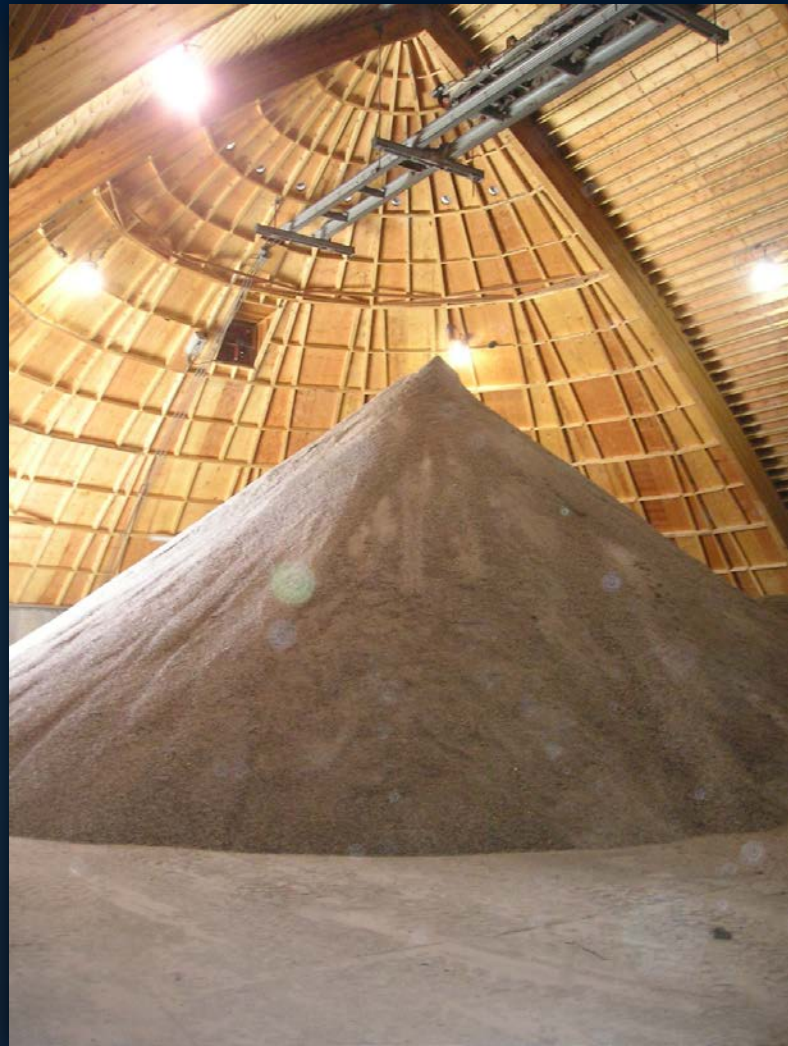
