Internet

A Web presence will be established for the project containing all materials and minutes at <http://fcgov.com/ctf>. Citizen comments will be accepted at the City's Web site starting at the time of the public launch. This input will be documented and summarized each month for the CTF, but citizens will not be guaranteed a reply.

Public Events

One public open house will be held early in the process (June?) to introduce the project to the public and gather input. A second public open house will be held after the initial draft recommendations are compiled, but before the City Council work session (October?)

Meetings with civic groups

City Council Advisory Board input

Input will be sought from project staff from the five participating Boards twice during the process in order to 1) review and provide comments on detailed select measures, and 2) to provide a recommendation on the draft plan. In addition, board representatives may wish to discuss Task Force progress with their boards throughout the process.
