Participate in and implement at least one measure through a City of Fort Collins or Utility program that has a climate benefit. Examples include <a href="#">Fort Collins Utilities programs</a> , XCEL programs, Transfort's <a href="#">PassFort program</a> and <a href="#">Bike to Work Day</a> breakfast station. (once)			✓	✓	
<b>Demonstrate and maintain</b> climate neutral status for your operation (purchasing offsets), <b>OR</b> participate in the Chicago Climate Exchange (CCX) <b>OR</b> participate in the California Climate Action Registry <b>OR</b> develop, and share with staff, a management system with climate focus (ISO 14001, ISO 14064, Sustainability Management System) <b>OR</b> earn the ENERGY STAR label for your facility or part of your facility <b>OR</b> earn a LEED™ certification for your facility or part of your facility. (once) <b>OR</b> implement an innovative program or initiative with significant climate benefits (requires Partner Advisory Committee approval)				✓	
Participate in the GREEN Works program. Implement 2 employee challenges per year to educate and encourage employees to help your organization move forward on conservation efforts. For smaller organizations, you may substitute customer education. Complete a challenge form for each challenge implemented.				annually

\*\*Partners have two years from achieving Bronze level to move to Silver level before dropping to inactive status.
