

# Anheuser-Busch Fort Collins Brewery



Caring for the environment is part of Anheuser-Busch's culture and history dating back to the time of our founder, Adolphus Busch in the late 1800s. Since that time, the company has become an industry leader in protecting the environment through support of conservation and recycling programs and by continuing to evaluate technologies that reduce our environmental impact.

## **In Fort Collins, some of our 2010 accomplishments include:**

- Planted close to 100 native trees at Riverbend Ponds Natural Area with help from employees and their families
- Implemented several water conservation initiatives, including making changes to brewing processes that resulted in a savings of more than 30 million gallons of water annually
- Implemented a composting program in our office areas and cafeteria
- Recycled more than 99% of the by-products generated at the brewery
- Implemented several energy conservation initiatives that resulted in a savings of more than 3.5 million kWh annually
- Maintained an 8-acre habitat for native plant and animal species on the northwest corner of the brewery property
