

Projects – Where do I start?

1. What kind of project was implemented?

Gadget related project:

- 'Plug-in' change
- Reported one time; benefit carried forward by myCW
- Usually energy or water related

Behavior related project:

- Project results depend on behavior related action
- Reported annually
- Ex. = recycling rates, turn off the lights, and bike commuting projects

2. How was the project implemented?

Professionally implemented

 Estimated savings already documented


Self implemented

- Data are available; simple calculation can be carried out
- More complex project requires assistance from ClimateWise staff





Project Reporting Workflow








What do I need to report every year?*

- Annually report recycling and/or composting.
 - What do I need?
 Bin size, type of material, % full, & frequency of pick-ups



– What do I need?

Track mileage, mode (i.e. SOV vs. carpool or SOV vs. bike), & frequency of alternative mode

*reporting 1 of these 2 projects is a program requirement









Data - Energy Projects

Data Required

1. Documentation of energy savings (kWhs or therms) from contractor or rebate application OR

- 2. Description of equipment prior to change (e.g. number, power, watts, type, or at least age)
- 3. Description of new equipment (e.g. power, watts, type)
- 4. Operational characteristics (e.g. hours per year that equipment is in operation)





Data - Water Projects

Data Required

1. Documentation of water savings (gallons or kgal) from contractor

OR

- 2. Description of equipment prior to change (e.g. flow rate or flush rate)
- 3. Description of new equipment (e.g. flowrate or flush rate)
- 4. Number of users (e.g. number of employees)
- 5. Type of environment (e.g. office)





Data - Solid Waste Projects

Data Required

1. Documentation of solid waste diversion (pounds, tons, cubic yards, gallons) from hauler

OR

- 2. Practice prior to change (e.g. landfilling)
- 3. Practice post change (e.g. recycling)
- 4. Material (e.g. aluminum, paper, etc.)
- 5. Size of container (e.g. 3 yd., 96 gal., etc.)
- 6. Frequency of pickup (e.g. weekly, on-call, etc.)





Data - Transportation Projects

Data Required

- 1. Practice prior to change
 - a. Mode
 - b. Mileage
 - c. Fuel Type
 - d. Vehicle Type



2. Practice post change (same data as above)





Project Form Tips

- What to know about 'Don't know'
- Are <u>all</u> projects ready for review?
- Report waste reduction and/or transportation related projects <u>every year!</u>
