FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will the street be closed?

Yes. Road closures are required to perform the work, however only one direction of traffic will be closed at a time. The directional closures are phased to allow access through the work zone. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times. Side streets adjacent to the closures will also be closed; alternate routes to residential areas are required. A map of the impacted street(s) with a phasing plan is located on the back of this sheet.

Will I have access to my business during construction?

You will have full access to your business when the road is scheduled to be closed. However, a short wait may occur while the paving operation is directly in front of your property/entrance. Alternate routes are suggested. Flaggers will be present onsite to help direct traffic.

How do I know if the project is delayed or dates changed?

Project dates are estimates based on favorable weather conditions; variances may occur due to unforeseen circumstances. ***In the event that the schedule is changed, updates will be posted online at www.fcgov.com/smp.*** More specific dates may also be added as the project progresses. Dates posted on "No Parking" signs will also be changed to reflect the current schedule.

How is a street selected for repair?

The City's Street Maintenance Program evaluates streets through an inspection process to identify the type and extent of pavement problems. From this analysis, the type of street treatment is determined. These treatments range from less costly surface treatments to more costly reconstruction.
