## Fort Collins Utilities' Cooling Rebate Program

*Rebates for high-efficiency air conditioning equipment*

### Be Cool and Save Energy

The Cooling Rebate Program (CRP) provides cash incentives to commercial customers installing new or replacement air conditioning equipment. Rebate amounts depend on the efficiency of the equipment, as shown below.

Ask your contractor or dealer about qualifying equipment and the application.

### Program Details

- Incentives are available until funding is expended in a given year.
- All Fort Collins Utilities commercial electric customers are eligible.

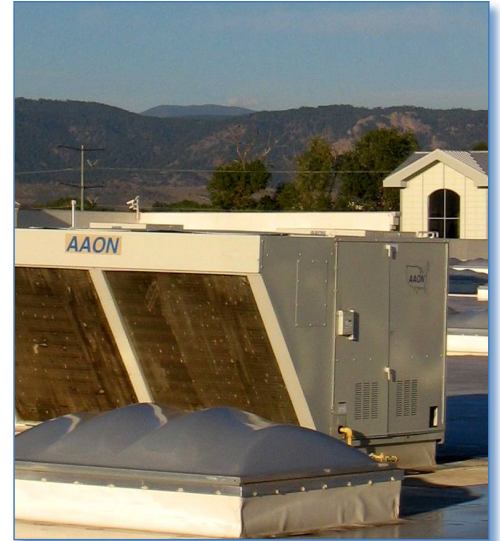
- Applications must be received within 60 days of installation date.
- The CRP is a collaboration between Fort Collins Utilities and Platte River Power Authority.

135,00-239,999 Btu/h	10.8 EER \$50 per ton	\$4 per ton for each 0.1 EER above 10.8
>240,000 Btu/h	10.0 EER \$50 per ton	\$4 per ton for each 0.1 EER above 10.0
<b>Equipment Type: Packaged Terminal Air Conditioners or Heat Pumps (PTACs)</b>		
All Sizes	11.0 EER \$50 per ton	\$4 per ton for each 0.1 EER above 11.0
