This interactive program will help you learn to reduce your household's electricity use, pay less on your monthly utility bill and decrease your carbon footprint. Be sure to bring your electric bill.

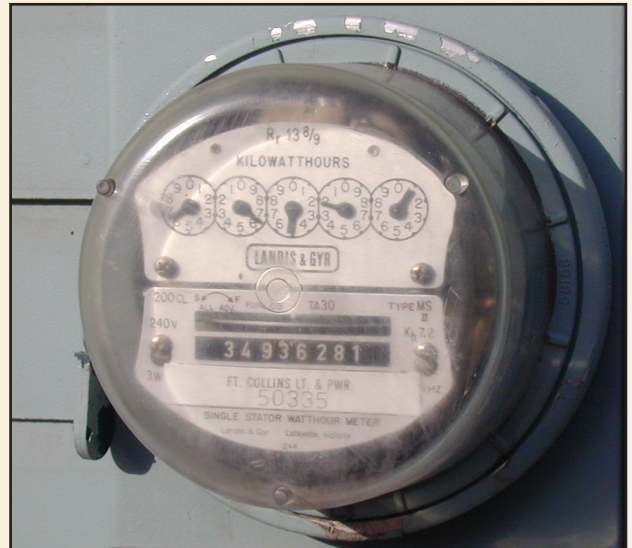
Gain a better understanding of how your electricity usage compares to other Fort Collins residents, where the electrons you pay for are being used and how to reduce electric costs.
