Information:

The Lincoln Center is a multi-venue performing and visual arts and conference facility, owned and operated by the City of Fort Collins, a municipal corporation. The Magnolia Theatre, constructed in 1978 and renovated in 2011, is a 224 seat proscenium theater and is intended as a user-serviced space. As such, it is the Presenter's responsibility to arrange for qualified technical support personnel for their event.

Directions to Lincoln Center:

Fort Collins is 60 miles north of Denver and 40 miles south of Cheyenne on Interstate 25. Take Exit 269 (Mulberry) west toward Fort Collins. Cross College Avenue (4 miles west of I-25) and continue west for three blocks. Facility is on the northwest corner of the intersection of Mulberry and Meldrum Streets, with a large sign visible from the corner. Enter the south parking lot via the driveway that opens onto Mulberry. A "Theater Truck Loading Zone" just inside this driveway runs perpendicular to Mulberry on the east side of the Mulberry pool. Stage door is on south side of building between Lincoln Center and Mulberry Pool building. Global Coordinates of the Lincoln Center are 40* 34' 55.40"N 105* 05' 00.00"W

Parking and Loading:

The loading doors are at street level, which is also stage level. There is neither ramp nor any stairs. When fully open, clearance through the exterior loading doors is 5'7" wide by 8'4" high (diagonal measurement approx 120"). Clearance through the backstage doors is 5'0" wide by 8'4" high high (diagonal measurement approx 113"). Since the dock alley is a fire lane, trucks MUST be moved after loading and unloading. Longterm parking in the "Theater Truck Loading Zone" must be arranged in advance, subject to availability.

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Stage Dimensions and Specifications

The **Proscenium** opening is variable in height, using a soft portal on a hand operated winch. Portal is piped, flat-sewn black duvetyn.

Proscenium Height: 15 ft-18 ft (soft header adjustable via winch stage right) Width: 30'10"

Stage width, including wings: 69'10"

Stage right wing: 19'7" Stage left wing: 19'5"

Stage depth: Back wall to proscenium 23'9" Back wall to edge of apron 30'11 1/2"

The stage apron extends 7'0" from the proscenium into the audience. Aisles at stage level extend into the audience at either side.

Wood floor: Construction: oak tongue & groove planks over subfloor, laid on 2X4 stringers over crawlspace. Finish is flat medium walnut.

Drilling or fastening into stage floor is not allowed.

Rigging Configuration

The Mini Theatre does not have a fly system. Lighting fixtures, masking and scenic elements may be hung or rigged from a grid of 1.5" ID steel pipe (clearance to floor of 20' 6"). Access to grid is via castered scaffolding or 14-23 foot "A" frame extension ladder. Weight restrictions apply to any grid-supported element. Technical director MUST be consulted for approval of scenic rigging or creative solutions.

Sound System

Mix position is in the booth at the rear of the house; operable windows allow Presenters' operators to hear the space.

- Mixer: Yamaha 01-V 12 mic pre/16channel digital.
- Speakers: 2 Bag End TA15 two-way cabinets, 2 SA18 subwoofers; located above stage L and R
- Amplifiers: Bag End Processor, Crest and Soundtech amplifiers in stage right amp rack
- Microphone snake (inputs 1-24) stage right at amp rack
- Playback: 2 Denon pro CD players with auto cue
- Portable speakers: EV 12-inch two-way stage monitors (2)
- One wired hand held microphone with stand
- Upon request: one Shure lavaliere or wireless handheld microphone

Crew Communications

Communications system includes a Clear-com single channel intercom system with one headset at Stage Manager's lectern stage left inside proscenium, and one in the light and sound booth that may be daisy-chained. Other headset jacks located stage left, stage right, and at the center of the house for a rehearsal/tech table. Audio monitors in dressing rooms feed from a fly mike over the stage.

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Lighting and Dimming System Information

The Control Booth is located at the rear of the house, through a door off the house right rear aisle. Work lights switches are located just within the backstage doors up stage left and inside proscenium down stage right. House lighting can be controlled from the booth or from audience level house right. <u>NOTE: Presenter is responsible for providing qualified</u> technical personnel for any customization of the space, technical elements or systems AND removing or restoring to base at the conclusion of the event.

Control System - ETC Expression 3X Version 3.11 with 2 memory crossfaders, 10 pages of 24 submasters, bump buttons, rate and level wheel, two color monitors, remote focus unit for onstage focus and cue playback.

Dimming System -_ETC Sensor Dimmers, 68/2400 watt dimmers plus house lights. Rack is addressable via 5-pin plug for DMX512 input from light booth or stage left wing.

Stage Lighting Positions and Circuits:

Please refer to current Magnolia Theatre floor plan or base lighting plot (or "rep" plot).

Instruments may be focused and gelled as desired. Additional inventory is available for specials and variations sufficient to most uses. Should your lighting designer or technician wish to move rep instruments, they may do so with the understanding that the cable must remain in place and that the rep plot must be restored in full during strike at the end of the production.

Performer Amenities - Dressing Rooms and Support Areas

DRESSING ROOMS

Dressing Room Suite

Room for 6-8 persons. Seated counter space with lighted mirrors, hanging racks, room for worktables/additional make up stations and private dressing area with sink and toilet/shower. A speaker in outer area monitors stage sound. Suitable for star dressing room, makeup/wardrobe/hair work room, green room or Production office.

Ensemble Dressing Room/Green Room

5 cubicles with lighted mirrors, counter space and clothing racks (room for 2-3 people each); men's and women's restrooms with showers, makeup area with lighted mirror and sink, and a small green room with seating area. Speakers in dressing rooms and green room monitor stage sound.

CROSSOVER.

A crossover passage with limited storage area is located directly behind the performance space. It is accessed via double doors upstage left and a single door upstage right. Props, set pieces and work tables must be kept clear of the mechanical equipment and the dedicated pathway through this space.

BACKSTAGE TRAFFIC

The hallway between the dressing room and stage access is a shared hallway AND is an emergency exit pass through. As such, it must be kept clear. Props tables, clothing racks or work areas must be kept within the confines of the dressing rooms or backstage.

General Information

- Catering, hospitality, and beverage service is the responsibility of the presenter. Contact Scheduling for kitchen availability and a list of approved caterers. *Liquor consumed in the facility* <u>must</u> be purchased from Lincoln Center concessionaire. Please consult with the Scheduling Coordinator.
- The Lincoln Center is a **NON-SMOKING** facility. Per Colorado Law and City ordinance, smoking is prohibited inside at all times, including contextual use in live theatre performance. A fire-safe ashtray is available for disposal in specifically approved locations on the south, north and west sides of the facility.
- Fire Code requires reasonable treatment of building and decorating materials in public Facilities. Additionally, use of pyrotechnics or open flame on stage **must be approved** through an application process with Poudre Fire Authority. Please contact the Technical Director for details. Application charges apply.
- Food or drink is not allowed onstage in the Magnolia Theatre. Exception is made for bottled water or scripted food or drink specific to your production, per advance notice to the Technical Director.
