



2008 COMMUNITY GARDEN AGREEMENT

The City of Fort Collins will provide the following:

1. A garden plot of approx. 150 square feet, amended with organic materials, rototilled and ready to plant by March 31st.
2. Portable water will be available on-site early season depending on the weather. Water, hoses and watering devices will be available in April to manually irrigate your plot. Starting June 1, The Gardens will run the automatic irrigation system 2-3 times per week.
3. Gardening information or referrals as requested.
4. Shared use of basic garden tools.
5. Mulching material and use of compost bins to dispose of community garden produced organic materials.
6. Use of bathrooms and water fountain during business hours.
7. Access to the community gardens from dusk to dawn seven days a week.

Gardeners will agree to:

1. Plan, plant, weed and harvest your plot during the gardening season of March 1 to October 31 and to maintain the area around the bed extending into the pathway. The plots are to be used for growing vegetables, flowers or herbs for personal (non-commercial) use only.
2. Contribute two hours during one of the three scheduled work days towards maintenance of the community garden area. These work days will be held on the following Saturdays, June 7, from 9 to 11 a.m.; Nov. 1 and Nov. 8 from 10 a.m. to noon. Projects will include pathway mulching, weeding and general clean-up.
3. Attend the community garden orientation on Saturday, February 9 from 9 to 10:30 a.m.
4. Provide your own seeds and "starts".
5. Provide for your own gardening tool needs, although some basic tools will be available for shared use. If a gardener has a tool preference we suggest they bring it with them.
6. Pay an annual gardening fee of \$80 to help offset some of the cost of preparing the garden site, providing water and administering the program. This amount includes a \$30 garden clean-up deposit, which will be refunded to you by December if you fulfill the required community service time of two hours, adequately maintain your plot and area immediately surrounding it and have it cleaned up by October 31st. This fee is non-refundable after April 15th. (If this is not affordable, let us know and we will try to provide some assistance.)
7. Start planting by May 15th, or gardeners will forfeit ½ of the garden fee.
8. Neither the deposit nor the gardening fee will be refundable to gardeners who abandon their plots after May 15th.
9. Read and follow the garden polices and pest control sheets on rules and responsibilities.

I understand and agree that neither the City of Fort Collins, Colorado nor any of its officers, agents, volunteers or employees shall be held responsible or made the subject of any claim for damages or liability arising from personal injury, property damage or loss of any sort to me, my guests or any other person or loss of any other sort arising out of or related to participation in programs at The Gardens on Spring Creek, whether the result of the negligence of the City of Fort Collins or any other person. I HEREBY AGREE TO RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, ITS OFFICERS, AGENTS, VOLUNTEERS AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY SUCH CLAIM, LIABILITY OR LOSS.

(See policy sheet for a description of our mulching regulations. One bale should be more than sufficient and will cost roughly \$10. You will have the opportunity to purchase mulch at the community garden orientation on February 9th.)
