Have you read all the Stephenie Meyer books, and you're still in vampire mode? Or are you just looking for some chilling reads for a cold fall night? Well, here are some books to try!

Anderson, M.T. *Thirsty*. Chris is a vampire who struggles with his thirst for blood while trying to retain his humanity.

Atwater-Rhodes, Amelia. *Demon in My View*. 17-year-old Jessica finds that her fictional vampire world is real when she develops relationships with an alluring vampire named Aubrey and the teenage witch who is trying to save Jessica from his clutches.

Atwater-Rhodes. *In the Forests of the Night*. Risika goes back in time to the year 1684, where she died as a human and was altered into vampirism against her will. Also read the other books in the Kiesha'ra series.

Gothic!: Ten Original Dark Tales. Edited by Deborah Noyes. Ten popular young adult authors share stories of the supernatural and surreal.

Cabot, Meg, et al. *Prom Nights from Hell*. Short stories of demons, ghosts, vampires, and gothic love by popular teen authors Meg Cabot, Kim Harrison, Michele Jaffe, Stephenie Meyer, and Lauren Myracle, reveal the dark side of the prom tradition.

Cast, P. C., and Kristin Cast. *Marked*. 16-year-old Zoë Redbird thinks she left her human problems behind when she entered the vampire world, but soon realizes troubles have followed her.

Clapp, Patricia. *Jane-Emily*. While spending the summer at the large, dark mansion of her grandmother, 18-year-old Louisa discovers an evil spirit that wants to possess her young niece, Jane.

Hahn, Mary Downing. *Look for Me by Moonlight*. 16-year-old Cynda feels increasingly isolated and finds solace in the attentions of Victor Morthanos, a charming but mysterious guest at her family's supposedly haunted Maine inn.

Hahn, Mary Downing. *Wait Till Helen Comes*. The eerie story of 12-year-old Molly, who tries to save her annoying 5-year-old stepsister from possession by an angry, wicked ghost.

Jackson, Shirley. *The Haunting of Hill House*. The classic horror story of the haunted Hill House, which is gathering its powers to possess one of four curious seekers trying to unlock its secrets.

King, Stephen. *Salem's Lot*. The frightening horror classic of a small, sleepy town in Maine that wakes to a new reality when vampires take over.

Klause, Annette Curtis. *Blood and Chocolate*. When she falls into forbidden love with a human boy, Vivian, a beautiful teenage werewolf, battles both her pack mates and the people of the boy's community.

Klause, Annette Curtis. *The Silver Kiss*. Zoë's new friend Simon, a teenage boy with a secret vampire identity, never expects to fall in love with her while helping her deal with her mother's terminal illness.

Letich-Smith, Cynthia. *Tantalize*. 17-year-old Quincie worries that her close friend, Keiren, a werewolf-in-training, is the prime suspect when multiple murders surround her family's vampire-themed restaurant.

Meyer, Stephenie. *Twilight*. Bella, a teenager who falls in love with an attractive and doting vampire named Edward, finds herself in a secret world of horror, danger, and fear where she must decide whether to forfeit her humanity for immortality. Don't miss the sequels, *New Moon* and *Eclipse*!

Night Terrors: Stories of Shadow and Substance. Edited by Lois Duncan. Read this selection of chilling tales from well-known masters of young adult literature.

Schreiber, Ellen. *Vampire Kisses*. 16-year-old Raven, an outcast who always wears black and is fascinated by vampirism, falls in love with the mysterious new boy in town. Also try the sequels, *Vampire Kisses 2: Kissing Coffins* and *Vampire Kisses 3: Vampireville*.

Shan, Darren. *Cirque du Freak*. When two best friends visit an illegal freak show, they encounter a vampire and a deadly spider that forces the boys to make life-changing choices. Also try the other books in the series.

Vande Velde, Vivian. *All Hallows Eve: Thirteen Stories*. Here are thirteen tales of Halloween horror, about ghosts, vampires, and pranks gone very wrong.

Vande Velde, Vivian. *Companions of the Night*. 16-year-old Kerry becomes the unwitting accomplice of Ethan, a handsome, strange boy on the run, only to find out that he is actually a vampire.

Westerfeld, Scott. *Peeps*. Cal Thompson is a carrier of a parasite that causes vampirism, and must hunt down all of the girlfriends he has unknowingly infected.

Wooding, Chris. *Haunting of Alazabel Cray*. Thaniel, a wuch-hunter, and Cathaline, his mentor, struggle to rid London's Old Quarter alleys of an infestation of terrible creatures, while helping a young woman who is either mad or possessed.

Wooding, Chris. *Poison*. Poison goes in search of her infant sister who was snatched by wicked fairies, and she encounters terrifying inhabitants of various Realms while discovering her own surprising destiny.
