

## Wild onion

Allum textile (Onion family)
Small mall white flowers in cluster on nodding stalk


## Sidebells penstemon

Penstemon secundiflorus (Plantain family) native.
Common Penstemon with flowers on one side of the stalk


## Blanketflower

Gaillardia aristata (Sunflower family) native.
These make bright spots in the prairie, and have a long blooming season

## Blue flax

Linum lewisii (Flax family) native. Generally only one flower opens on a stem per day, then quickly withers and drops.


## Whiskbroom parsley

Harbouria trachypleura (Carrot family) native.
These make bright spots of color early in the season. The leaves are finely divided and look whiskbroom-like


## Two grooved milkvetch

Astragalus bisulcatus (Pea family) native. Along roadside (look south of gatehouse). Not abundant this year. Also a white variety

## Calcareous cryptantha

Oreocarya thyrsiflora (Borage family) native.

Common, sturdy plants that bloom almost all summer. Each small white flower is like a gem set among foliage with long, stiff white hairs that give the plant a grayishgreen color.


## Wallflower

Erysimum capitatum (Mustard family) native.
Used medicinally in a variety of ways by Native Americans.
