



Welcome to City of Fort Collins Gateway Natural Area

Important Gateway Natural Area Rules

1. Gateway parking pass required from March 1 to November 30.
Daily Vehicle Pass - \$5 Vehicle with 8 or more occupants - \$10.
2. Open year-round from dawn to dusk – Gates close automatically at dusk.
3. No overnight parking and no camping.
4. Alcohol consumption or possession prohibited.
5. Pets must be leashed at all times – strictly enforced.
6. Fires are restricted to on-site grills and portable table-top gas grills only.
7. Burning of wood in any outdoor grill prohibited.
8. All events require a permit.
9. Using amplification without a permit or making, continuing, or causing to be made or continuing any unreasonable noise is not allowed.
10. Fishing upstream of the confluence of the North Fork and the Poudre River (immediately upstream of the first bridge, the wood bridge) is “Catch and Release Only” and artificial flies and lures only.
11. No hunting and no possessing or discharging a weapon. Exception: a state-licensed hunter may transport an unloaded, open-chambered weapon through Gateway from Sept 1 through Feb 28 (During the state licensed hunting season).
12. No riding or leading a horse/mule etc. Exception: During an open big game season and then only ride or lead a horse on main roadways.
13. All other City of Fort Collins, Division of Wildlife (CDOW), and state boating regulations apply.
14. General state fishing regulations apply to Seaman Reservoir (City of Greeley). See CDOW regulations. Live bait and fish possession are permitted.
15. Access to Seaman Reservoir is restricted to west and south side only.
