The structures described herein are all unlined gravel mining pits that have been, or are in the process of being, reclaimed. They are off-channel structures that fill by ground water infiltration from the alluvium of the Cache La Poudre River and capture of surface runoff inflows. These structures do not have specific fill ditches or dams. Fort Collins claims the right to fill and continuously refill these structures in accordance with their priorities. The surface areas and

capacities described are estimates based on available information at the time of this notice. The actual surface areas at the high water line may be larger or smaller. Fort Collins will use the water rights for the following beneficial uses: recreation, aesthetic, fishing, maintenance of wildlife and wildlife habitat, including piscatorial use, preservation of wetland areas and plant species, storage, augmentation, replacement, evaporation, and maintenance of ponds as natural areas, including the right to fill and continuously refill as depletions occur in accordance with the priorities for the structures. The uses will occur at and around the location of the ponds.
