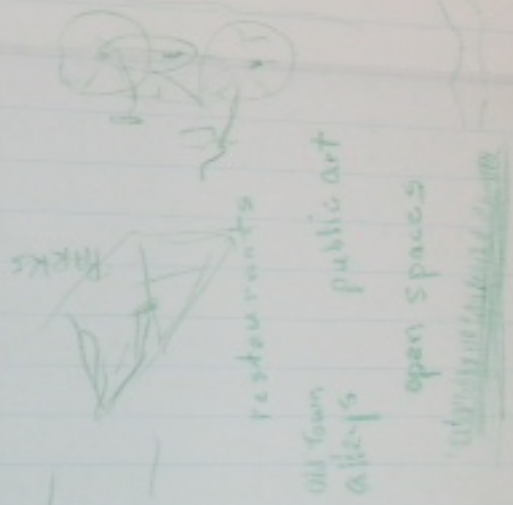
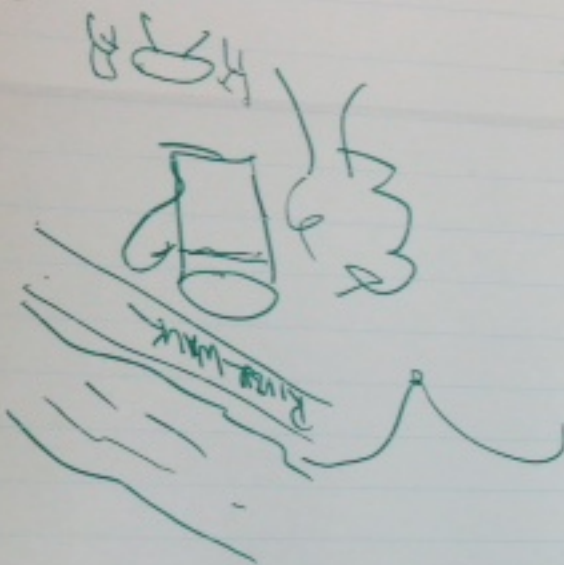


Attendees watched a Ted Talk video where Peter Kageyama described his research and subsequent book, *For the Love of Cities*: www.youtube.com/watch?v=6K7OKw_rSz0. In it, he discusses what it is that makes cities lovable and how local government can support those initiatives and items to improve the relationship between citizens and their sense of place. The video also introduces the concept of co-creation; indicating that there are persons who engage (about 1%) at such a high level in community that they technically assist in co-creating the community.

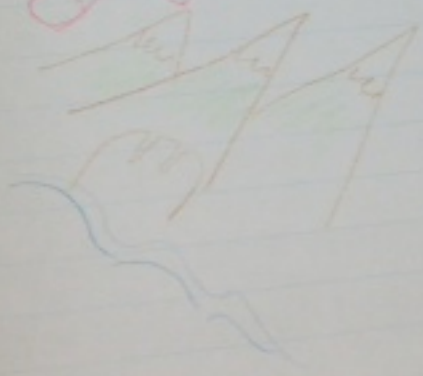
