Comments: The "average" row shows how many of the 8 options participants chose. Formal leaders chose an average of 5, while all others chose only 2.9. Those in HOAs chose 4.6, while those not chose only 2.7.

95% of formal leaders said "Maintain common properties" for formal leaders" was a responsibility being performed, while only 37% of others did so. Similarly, 76% of those in HOAs, while only 19% of those not in HOAs.

This question was added during the process in order to have a comparison to question 3.
