

southeast community park


approximately 20 acres is made up of a riparian creek corridor.





- Traffic concerns with park entrances on Kechter Road
- Preference for park entrance off of Ziegler Road
- Lighted ball and turf fields
- Playground too close to Kechter Road
- Unsightly BMX course highly visible from Ziegler Road





















- Driving down a long narrow driveway








Neighborhood Concerns Addressed

- Parking is distributed around the park
- Primary park entrance off Ziegler instead of Kechter
- Multi-purpose fields are not lighted, ball fields are lighted
- Playground is a safe distance from major roads
- BMX course is not in a prominent location
