- Provide input on monument design to celebrate historical significance of neighborhoods
- Engage other neighborhood residents in discussions about the projects and bring feedback to committee

Meetings will be held quarterly, beginning in **May 2015**. They will be held on **Wednesday evenings** and will last approximately 1.5 hours.

Neighborhood discussions and engagement coordination will be expected and should take place outside of the established meeting times.
