

ORDINANCE NO. 031, 2014
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
APPROPRIATING UNANTICIPATED GRANT REVENUE FROM
KAISER PERMANENTE IN THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FUND
FOR THE 2014 FORT COLLINS BIKES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in 2013, the League of American Bicyclists officially designated the Fort Collins community as a “Platinum-level Bicycle Friendly Community”; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded a Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of Colorado Walk and Wheel local government grant from Kaiser Permanente for the Fort Collins Bikes (FC Bikes) Program in the amount of \$94,100; and

WHEREAS, no local matching funds are required for the Walk and Wheel grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will support the 2014 FC Bikes Program initiatives, allowing for refinement and expansion of current services, including enhanced bicycle safety education programs, expanded encouragement campaigns, new bicycle promotion initiatives, and development and implementation of the 2014 Fort Collins Bicycle Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, Article V, Section 9, of the City Charter permits the City Council to make supplemental appropriations by ordinance at any time during the fiscal year, provided that the total amount of such supplemental appropriations, in combination with all previous appropriations for that fiscal year, does not exceed the current estimate of actual and anticipated revenues to be received during the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, City staff has determined that the appropriation of the revenue as described herein will not cause the total amount appropriated in the Transportation Services Fund to exceed the current estimate of actual and anticipated revenues to be received in that fund during any fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that there is hereby appropriated from unanticipated grant revenue in the Transportation Services Fund the sum of NINETY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$94,100) for expenditure in the Transportation Services Fund for the Fort Collins Bikes Program in 2014.
