While construction recycling has numerous benefits for our community and the environment, it also has great potential for lowering job site costs. By implementing programs that recycle or recover re-usable wood, metals, and other debris on job sites, hauling costs will be reduced, the useful life of our landfill will be extended, and re-usable material can be recovered for other projects.
