

Expanded Plastics Recycling in Fort Collins

- * Curbside pickup
- * Rivendell drop off facility
- * Larimer County Recycling Center

Here's the complete listing of the acceptable and non-acceptable plastics that can now be recycled in Fort Collins.

Please remember: It's critical that all plastic be clean and free of food debris.

No containers larger than 2-1/2 gallons are allowed.

YES!

ACCEPTABLE PLASTIC CONTAINERS

- Narrow-necked containers, #1 and #2; caps removed
- Any container stamped #3 through #7 (except those listed under "Unacceptable Plastics" below)
- Wide-mouth containers stamped #1 through #7 (e.g., butter/cottage cheese tubs, etc.); snap-on lids are okay
- Yogurt containers stamped #1 through #7; snap-on lids are okay
- Clear clamshells (e.g., sandwich or cookie containers from the deli or bakery), stamped #1 through #7
- Personal care/prescription bottles stamped #1 through #7
- Pails stamped #1 through #7; snap-on lids are okay
- Flower and garden pots stamped #1 through #7
- #7 Nalgene bottles

NO!

UNACCEPTABLE PLASTICS

- Frozen entrée microwave trays
- Food trays or party platters even if stamped with #1-#7
- Film (e.g., shrink wrap, Saran wrap, etc.)
- Plastic bags
- Automotive chemical containers including motor oil and anti-freeze bottles
- Pesticide containers
- Styrofoam containers
- #5, #6 and #7 compostable bottles or cups (these will be marked "compostable" by the manufacturer)
