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## Sales and Use Tax Collection Report – May 2013

Issued June 10, 2013


This report reflects Sales and Use Tax collected in May for economic activity that occurred in April. Please note the sales and use tax collected in May is predominately from April sales but also includes delinquent collections from prior periods.

Year to date, sales and use tax collections excluding rebates are up 3.3% and total \$44.3 million.

May Sales Tax Budget to Actual. In May 2013, sales tax collected in Fort Collins was \$70K under the amount budgeted. Year to date, the City has collected 0.6% more sales tax revenue than budgeted, for a net gain of \$224K.

May Use Tax Budget to Actual Excluding Rebates. In May 2013, use tax collected in Fort Collins was \$304K over the amount budgeted. Year to date, the City has collected 11.6% more use tax revenue than budgeted for a net gain of \$704K.


Figure 5. Sales and Use Tax Collected		May		Year to Date

**May Sales Tax Collected.** In May 2013, sales tax collected in Fort Collins increased 1.7% over May 2012. Sales tax collected totaled \$7.0 million compared to \$6.8 million in 2012.

**May Use Tax Collected.** The total use tax collected in May was \$1.6 million, a decrease of 12.4% compared to last May. The estimated use tax collected in May related to economic incentive agreements was \$56,617 as illustrated on Figure 5. This amount will be rebated in the succeeding calendar year. The net use tax collections for May totaled \$1.5 million for a net 7.8% decrease.


Total Sales and Use Tax Collected. Total tax collected of \$8.5 million was 1.2% lower than last May.

At the national level, March retail sales (as reported on May 13th) increased 3.7% compared to the increase in Fort Collins' sales of 1.8%. April sales are the basis for the City's May sales tax collections and net taxable amounts (which are included in this report).

Figure 10. May - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax




Figure 11. Year to Date - Net Taxable Sales Subject to Sales Tax




Figure 12. Supplementary Information

**Sales and Use Tax in the City's Downtown Area.** The sales and use tax collected in May for the downtown area decreased 5.7% from the same period in 2012.

**Lodging Tax Collections.** The City collected \$77,065 in lodging taxes in May. This was an increase of 12.1% from May 2012.

**Sales Tax Licenses.** The City received 75 applications for sales tax licenses for new businesses and 56 businesses terminated their license in May. There were 10,958 active sales tax licenses at the end of May.
