City Allocates Federal Funds for Affordable Housing and Community Development

On Tuesday November 16, 2004, the Fort Collins City Council formally adopted the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Funding Allocation for community development and affordable housing proposals submitted for the Fall 2004 Competitive Process funding cycle.

All proposals were considered eligible for funding, and were subject to criteria ranking. There were \$2.3 million in requests and only \$2 million in available dollars. The funding results are as follows:
