**1st/2nd Grade Ultimate Football**

**4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Tackle Football**

This tackle football program will teach youngsters fundamentals and teamwork. The main emphasis is on sportsmanship and equal participation with winning being secondary. Physicals are highly recommended before competing in this program. Youth Football and the Fort Collins Soccer Club's fall season coincide; youngsters may not participate in both sports. Practice attendance is mandatory; players must attend practices to receive equal playing time in games. Practices are held two to three times per week with most games being played on Saturday mornings.

**GRADE:** 4 & 5 (2009-2010)

**NOTE:** Registration deadline is 8/14; equipment handout begins 8/17 for 4th grade, 8/18 for 5th grade. Tackle season begins the week of Monday, August 24; \$99; 8 games scheduled. Participants must purchase a mouthpiece; all other equipment is furnished.

North and south of Drake Road and east and west of College Avenue define the practice areas. Youngsters will be divided into teams based on weight (lightweight and heavyweight).
