



Proposed Route Changes

March 2009

Route 4

This route is proposed to be eliminated due to not meeting performance standards. Resources from Route 4 are planned to be used to better serve the area that is currently served by Route 6.

Route 5

Route 5 is proposed to be extended north on Lemay Avenue between Mulberry Street & Lincoln Avenue. This change will help to better serve the Fort Collins Super Wal-Mart.

Route 6

Route 6 is proposed to exit the CSU Transit Center (CTC) and proceed north on Loomis Avenue; then west on Mulberry Street. This change covers a portion of Route 4 that is proposed to be eliminated. Route 6 is planned to travel along Taft Hill Road between Mulberry Street & Horsetooth Road. On Horsetooth Road this route travels east & west between Taft Hill Road & the South Transit Center (STC). This change helps set the foundation for a "grid like" system.

Route 7

Due to limited ridership on one of the half hour trips, Route 7 is proposed to now run at 60 minute frequency. The Route 7 is planned to depart the STC at :15 minutes after each hour; and departs CSU Transit Center at :45 minutes after each hour. The second bus that used to serve this bus route is planned to shift to support Transfort's newest bus route (see Route 19).

Route 8

Route 8 is planned to travel down Willow Street instead of Jefferson Avenue to better serve the Atzlan Center.

Route 9

This route's departure times are planned to shift to :22 minutes after each hour. (used to depart at :52 after each hour.) This change aligns more directly with Lincoln Junior High & Poudre High School start and end times.

Route 17

Due to minimal boardings on Limon Drive & Custer Drive, Route 17 will remain on Timberline Road between Custer Drive & Drake Road, with a new bus stop installed on Timberline Road close to the King Soopers store.

Route 18

Due to minimal boardings at Edora Pool and Ice Center (EPIC) Route 18 is planned to stay on Prospect Rd. between Sharp Point Drive and Stover Street. New bus stops are planned for the Prospect Road and Riverside Avenue area.

New Route 19

Route 19 is planned to serve the area between CSU and Front Range Community College, traveling on Shields Street. This bus route operates every 60 minutes, Monday-Friday, year-round, leaving CTC at :15 after each hour. When Poudre School District is in session, Route 19 operates every 30 minutes (peak times only), leaving CTC at :15 and :45 min after each hour.
