What area does the project cover?

North College Avenue - Vine Drive to the Hickory/Conifer intersection (approximately 1/2 mile). See map below.

How was this project initiated?

Through Building on Basics (BOB) – a voter approved 1/4 cent sales tax to fund capital projects. This project is actively supported by the NFCBA.

What previous planning efforts have been completed for North College?

- North College Corridor Plan - adopted in 1994/updated in 2007
- US 287/SH 14 Access Management Plan - adopted in 2000
- North College Urban Renewal Plan – adopted in 2004.

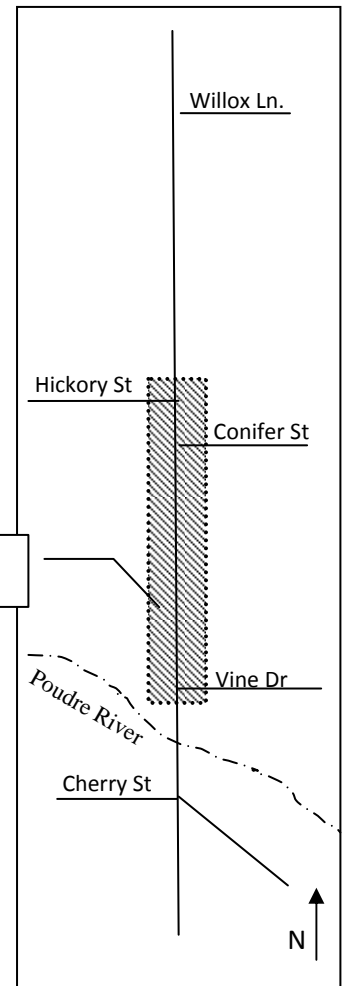
What elements does the project include?

How is the project funded?

Local Funds: \$4.7 million – BOB Funding

Federal/State Funds: \$885,000

The City is currently seeking additional funding and partnership opportunities.

How long will it take to complete the project?

- December 2008 - August 2009 Conceptual Design
- August 2009 - December 2010 Design Engineering and Right-of-Way Acquisition
- 2011 – Begin Construction
