Professional Landscapers Fall Checklist

- □ Check lawnmowers, trimmers and leaf blowers for leaking fluids. Repair any leaks found.
- □ Clean tools and equipment on the lawn or grassy areas.
- □ Cover lawn equipment or move it indoors.
- □ Regularly rake and compost leaves.
- Always blow or rake leaves into piles on lawns or other grassy surfaces, never onto pavement.
 City of Fort Collins ordinance prohibits leaf blowing into streets.
- □ Bag leaves or cover them with a tarp before taking them to a drop-off site.
- □ Prune trees and compost or mulch trimmings.
- □ Mow the lawn one last time before winter. Keep grass to three inches or less.
- Aerate so plants will absorb water and nutrients over winter months.
- □ Fertilize lawns in early fall if you fertilize twice per year.
- □ Use organic or slow-release fertilizers.
- Do not apply fertilizer to lawns on rainy or windy days.
- □ Store leftover fertilizer in containers with lids or in covered areas.
- □ Take unwanted fertilizer and other lawn chemicals to hazardous waste collection sites.
- Dry out sprinkler systems. Freezing underground sprinkler pipes can burst and cause leaking water to wash fertilizer, leaves and grass clippings into storm drains.
- □ Use leaf and debris vacuums for small, stray leaves or aeration cores.
