- What limitations you may encounter.

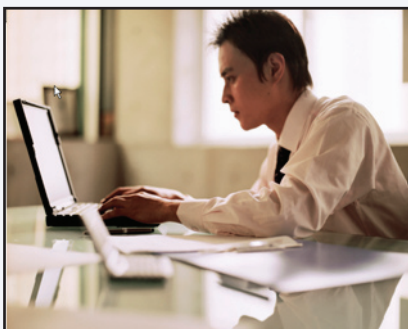

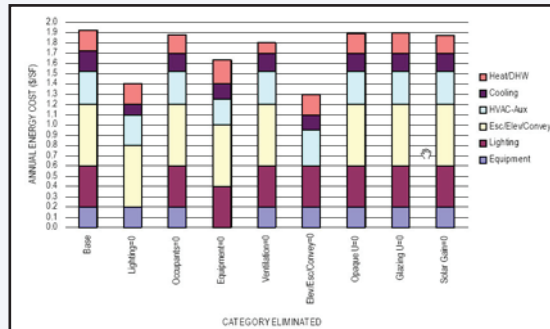
