WASTEWATER PLANT INVESTMENT FEE (PIF) SCHEDULE¹

The Wastewater Plant Investment Fee (PIF) is a one-time development fee collected to pay for growth related capital expansion costs of wastewater collection, transmission and treatment facilities. The fee varies with the number of dwelling units for residential users and the size of the water meter and strength of discharge for non-residential users. City Code requires that each building have its own sanitary sewer service tap. Payment of the PIF is made at the Building and Zoning Department upon issuance of a building permit.

Non-residential customers discharging higher strength wastewater exceeding the average concentrations of BOD (>200 mg/l), COD (>300 mg/l), TOC (>100 mg/l) and/or TSS (>250 mg/l) for their customer class are subject to a PIF surcharge. Examples of high strength wastewater discharge categories and the amount of their Wastewater PIF's are shown below. To obtain fees for categories of high strength discharge customers not appearing on the list, contact the Utilities for the Wastewater PIF.
