
Transformer Cabinet Mural Project 2017 Artist: Sharon Smith Location: 1598 W Elizabeth (SP35457)





For this concept, I use repeating circles to create a floral motif. The circles represent interconnectedness. They have no beginning or end and occur repeatedly in our environment-from pupils, to wheels, to planets. The simplified flowers reflect the human brain's tendency to simplify the environment.





This concept was inspired by my love of summer in Ft.Collins. The mountains and river connect each side of the cabinet. Trees support each corner, framing each view and forming an interconnected canopy on the top of the cabinet. This concept will remind viewers of our beautiful summers all year long.
