<sup>\*\*\*</sup> Remodel/addition permit submittal must be applied for prior to or concurrently with demolition application for interior structural demo if applicant intends to start demolition early (prior to issuance of remodel/addition permit).

- 1. Separate demo permits are optional for non-structural interior demo work and offered as aconvenience for residential remodel projects wanting to get started with demolition prior to full permit approval.
- 2. Demo work can be done on additions and remodel permits or on a separate demo permit.
