SELECTING A LOCATION: WHERE CAN I DO BUSINESS? WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Contact City of Fort Collins Zoning
 - Verify that your location is properly zoned to operate your business: <u>fcgov.com/zoning</u>
 - Development review may be required, followed by building permits
- Apply for development review
 - Conceptual meeting: <u>fcgov.com/developmentreview/applications.php</u>
 - Considerations may include use, occupancy, parking, utilities and building alterations.
- Apply for permits
 - Construction, building and fire authority permits: <u>fcgov.com/building/application.php</u>

Contact Floodplain Administration staff at 970-416-2632 or <u>floodplainadministration@fcgov.com</u> before undertaking any construction (new development, additions, remodels, filling, grading, etc.) on a building or property located in a regulatory floodplain to determine specific floodplain requirements.

A floodplain use permit is required for any work done in the floodplain. Different floodplains have different regulations.

SALES TAX

Register with tax entities at the City, state and federal level. The City of Fort Collins uses a Sales & Use Tax License as a business license.

- **City:** To register for licenses, city taxes, file returns and manage tax accounts, visit *fcgov.com/salestax*
- State: For state taxes and a Sales Tax ID number, visit <u>mybiz.colorado.gov</u> to register your business and file with the state

All Brick and Mortar, Home-Based Businesses, and Service-Based Businesses (e.g. a contractor that works/performs services in Fort Collins regardless if they live or have a business located in Fort Collins) are required to have a Sales & Use Tax License with the City.

Federal: All forms of structure, except sole proprietors with no employees, must obtain a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN), which is also your federal tax ID number.

BE A RESPONSIBLE EMPLOYER

If your business will have employees, you must:

- register as an employer with the Colorado Department of Labor & Employment
- pay additional taxes
- withhold, match and submit employee withholdings
- obtain worker's compensation insurance
- follow other employee eligibility regulations
- Establish a required unemployment insurance account with the Colorado Department of Labor through Colorado Business Express - <u>colorado.gov/cbe</u>
