While searching for a temporary day shelter, Catholic Charities Northern, the Fort Collins Area United Way, and staff have been searching for a permanent location for a day shelter. The permanent shelter would provide a wide array of services and act as a one-stop-shop for the homeless population. Staff is looking at a number of sites that could be potential day shelters. These sites must meet a handful of criteria such as a proximity to night shelters and other services, avoidance of residential neighborhoods and downtown businesses, and proximity to bus service. Staff will be presenting available options at the Study Session.

At Council's request, staff developed a *Periodic Review Process* which was adopted on February 20, 2001 by Resolution 2001-26 as a part of the Boards and Commissions Manual.
