Includes a Climate Action Plan, Energy Policy and Road to Zero Waste Plan. Adopted in March. Aiming for a goal of 100% renewable by 2030 (additional interim targets), 80% reduction in GHG by 2030, Carbon Neutral by 2050 and Zero Waste by 2030. High focus on Equity in the climate future approach. Community engagement consisted of; community partners and plan ambassadors,



community conversations, pop up events, and online engagement. Big Moves: 13 major outcomes to address equity goals and resilience goals related to climate future.

City Council adopted Climate Future Plan. Components of the two-year tactical plan: detailed description of initial next moves, provide clear expectations of OCF actions in 2021 and 2022, updated next year to get on the BFO cycle.
