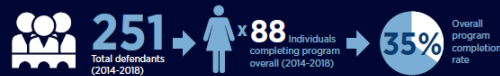


MUNICIPAL COURT 2018 SPECIAL PROGRAMS BY THE NUMBERS

Fort Collins Municipal Court is responsible for administering operations of the judicial branch of City government according to the City Charter and ordinances adopted by City Council. Within that framework, the Court continues to develop alternative sentencing options that encourage and assist defendants to lead law-abiding lives, including Special Agency Sessions and the Transitional Sentencing Program.

SPECIAL AGENCY SESSIONS

Special Agency Sessions are intended to address and resolve cases while balancing compassion and resourcefulness with accountability. This program was added to the services that Municipal Court offers in 2014 to address the concerns with "quality of life" violations for people who are experiencing homelessness and/or have other service needs.

INCREASING IMPACT OR PERCEPTION OF IMPACT ON PUBLIC



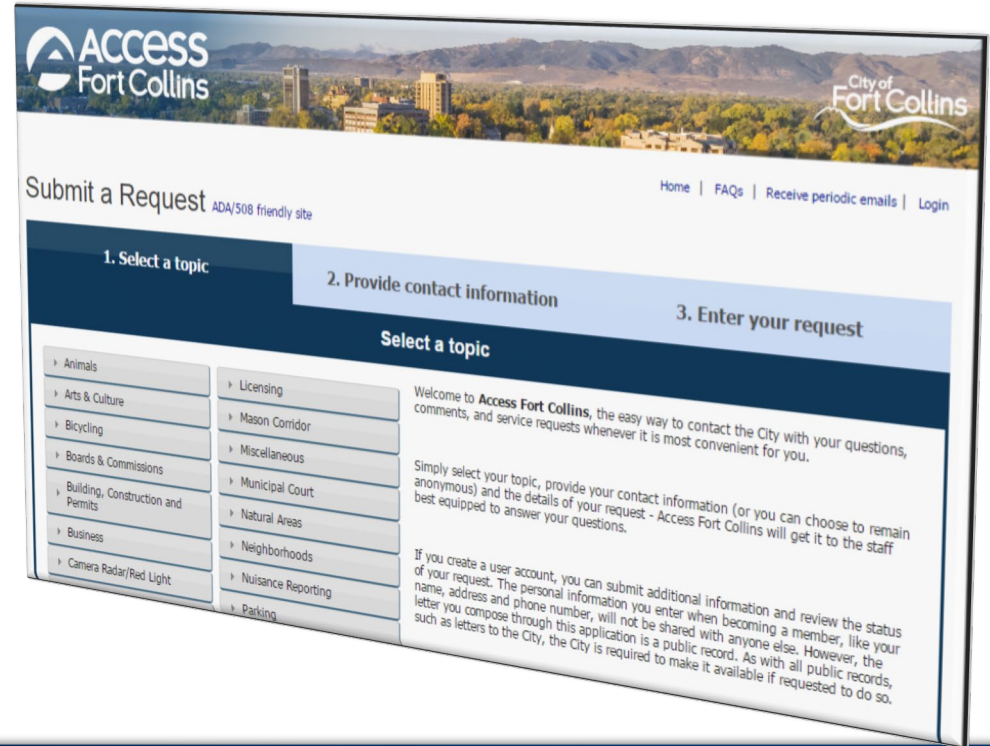
Public engagement is not always a linear process and communicators should feel empowered to move between levels as needed.

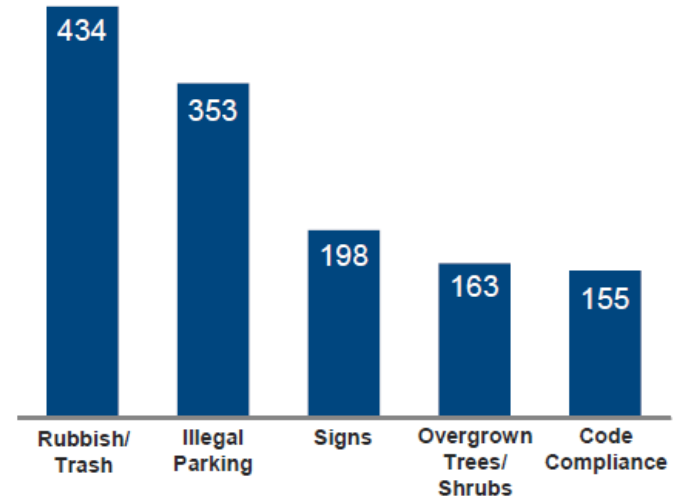
