



Local Fixed Route





1 fixed route from Downtown to areas surrounding CSU campus


- Friday and Saturday Night

Dial-A-Ride - Paratransit




- Complementary Paratransit: Service to individuals who, because of a disability, are unable to access fixed route.
- ADA Minimum Service levels: ¾
 of a Mile from any Local Fixed
 Route
- Service Contracted Through Local Taxi Company (Veolia)



Dial-A-TAXI – Disabled Service



- \$20 Voucher towards Taxi service
- Available to all Dial-A-Ride Customers
- Provides convenience for last minute trips or trips beyond our service hours and boundaries
