On April 21, 2021, the City of Fort Collins Development Review Division received and processed a request for the Lorenzen Minor Subdivision, being a request for a Basic Development Review to replat two lots in the Loomis Subdivision into one single lot. The two lots are commonly known as 831 W. Olive St. and 308 S. Washington Ave., located at the southeast corner of West Olive and Washington. Total area of the replat is 15,000 sq. ft. (each of the two lots was 7,500 sq. ft.). The existing zoning Neighborhood Conservation Low Density (NCL). This request has been processed in accordance with Section 2.18.3 – Basic Development Review Procedures, of the City of Fort Collins Land Use Code pursuant to the applicable standards in the Land Use Code.

The Development Review Manager hereby makes the following findings of fact:
