PROPOSAL INFORMATION


- Provide a 12' wide concrete trail, graded to meet ADA requirements and striped to support 2-way bicycle and pedestrian movement to provide direct, safe connectivity for users of Spring Creek trail into the larger Fort Collins Centre Ave bikeway network which provides direct access to CSU.
- The southern segment of the trail includes a pedestrian bridge spanning 60' from the City's Lilac Park over Spring Creek and is the specific subject of this review.
- Requires review and a decision by the Planning and Zoning Commission at a public hearing.
