## PUBLIC NOTICE – TWO-WEEK OPEN COMMENT PERIOD

June 5, 2020

Dear Property Owner or Resident:

The City of Fort Collins has received a request for a change to the subdivision plat for the Larimer County Jail Midpoint Campus on Midpoint Drive. The subdivision plat is under review under the name: **Larimer County Jail Replat, BDR190019**. The formal name of the subdivision plat is the *Larimer County Midpoint Campus – Second Filing*. The overall size of the subdivision is approximately 35.97 acres. No new lots are being created with this subdivision replat. This replat proposes to reconfigure three existing lots within the subdivision by shifting property lines within the campus. The overall size of the subdivision is not changing, and the perimeter property lines are unchanged.

This subdivision is being processed per the City's Land Use Code as a Minor Subdivision under Section 2.18 of the code which allows this request to be considered by the Planning Director administratively versus a public hearing. Prior to the Planning Director's decision, code requires this mailed notification and a two-week open comment period during which comments can be provided to the Planning Services Department. This open comment period will be:

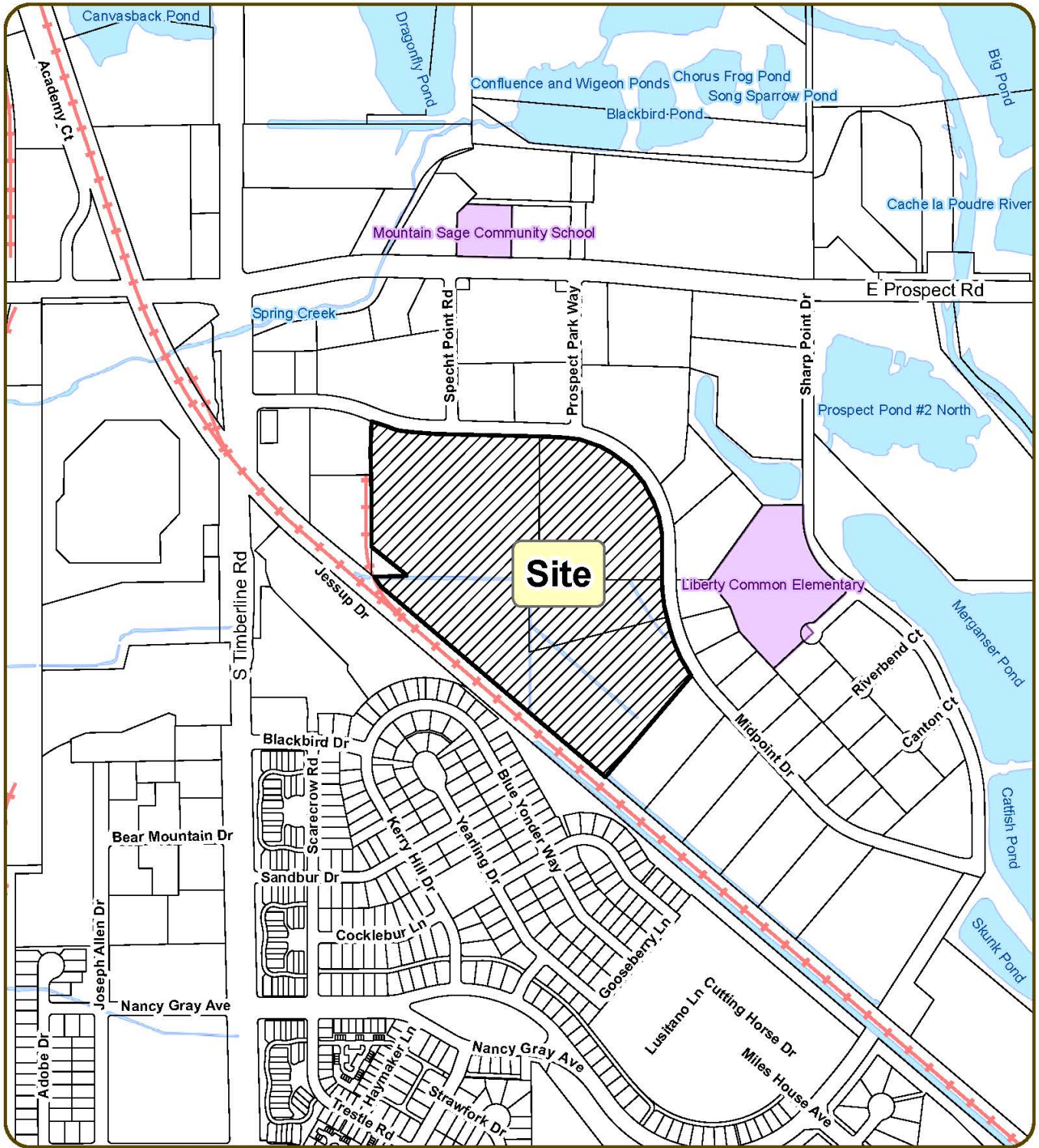
