

- Utilize a portion of the City-owned building at 117 N. Mason St. for overflow shelter for men experiencing homelessness from November 2023 – April 2024.
- The site, operated by Fort Collins Rescue Mission, will offer shelter overnight-only for up to 44 men.
- The site is in the Downtown (D) Zone District.
