This letter is to inform you that the City of Fort Collins is in the process of creating new regulations related to oil and gas development. As an owner or occupant of a residence within 2,000 feet of an active oil well, we are interested in your input. Information about this process is posted at www.fcgov.com/oilandgas, including:

- A Fact Sheet prepared by the Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE) on potential health risks associated with oil and gas development
