Dear Property Owner or Resident:

This letter is to let you know of two proposed Parks Department developments near your property, and to invite you to a neighborhood meeting where you can learn more about the two related proposals. Basic information about the meeting and the proposals is to the right and on the back of this letter.

You received this notice because records from the Larimer County Assessor's Office indicate you own property near the proposed developments. Because of the lag time in recordkeeping, or because of rental situations, some neighbors may be missed. Please feel free to notify your neighbors of the meeting so they can attend. If you own or manage an apartment building, please post this notice in a common area so your residents can participate.

Parks planners need your input to shape the design of the park, and to provide input regarding the maintenance facility. A supervised, kid-friendly area will be available at the meeting.

TWO PROPOSED DEVELOPMENTS

- 1) <u>A Neighborhood Park along Miles</u> <u>House Drive.</u>
- 2) <u>A Parks Department Park Shop</u> <u>Building on Environmental Drive,</u> <u>CDR190082.</u>

Both sites are parts of the overall Bucking Horse development plan. (Location map on the back of this letter).

PROPOSAL DESCRIPTIONS

- Both proposals are in the earliest stages of programming and design. Character and specific features would be determined with neighborhood input and further consideration of the neighborhood context.
- The parks shop maintenance facility would typically include an office/shop building, vehicle and equipment storage, fencing and landscaping along with any other features that emerge in the process.
- Both proposals are located in the Urban Estate (UE) Zone District.
- The parks shop proposal will require a review and public hearing by the Planning & Zoning Board (P&Z), and a hearing by City Council.
- Residents who receive this letter will also receive a letter for the P&Z hearing.
