- 8 parking spaces, including new 6-space rear parking lot and alley improvements
- City Council must separately approve a lease agreement at a future Council meeting

- The proposal includes modification of standard requests to the Fort Collins Land Use Code relating to:
  - Floor area and height of the existing structure
  - Maximum number of group home residents
  - Separation distance from an existing group home
